## Four-star victory with five-star feeling for Cassio Rivetti

**(Hagen a.T.W.)** „Hagen is a five-star tournament for me – not only as regards sports, but also when it comes to the general conditions and overall atmosphere,” says the winner of the CSI\*\*\*\* two-phase jumper class, prize of Performance Sales International GmbH, Cassio Rivetti. And it perfectly matched the sponsor of this test that the show jumping rider, born in Brazil and competing for the Ukraine, rode a former P.S.I. horse, the 10-year-old Chacco-Blue daughter Chataga.

Rivetti will participate with exactly this mare at the Nations Cup at the beginning of May in Linz in Austria: “The arena there is similar to the one here at Horses & Dreams, and this was the reason why I decided to start with Chataga here in Hagen, too. The mare is in top form and already won the last two jumper classes at 1.50 m in Lummen.” He relies on the 10-year-old Belgian horse Forlap for the qualifier for the DKB-Riders Tour on Sunday, the best horse he ever had. Together with trainer René Tebbel, the Ukrainian team is already now working to prepare for the qualification for the Olympics in Rio in 2016.

Felix Haßmann from Lienen was the best competitor from Germany with Horse Gym's Balzaci. He finished fourth and is also well prepared for the weekend.

## In time like a Quartz-watch

Time jumper classes are the most entertaining tests in show jumping sport. The challenge for the horse-rider-combinations is not to accomplish faultless courses to finally qualify for the decisive jump-off – they have to speed up immediately to earn top places. Thus each ride is a thrilling jump-off performance.

Tim Rieskamp-Goedeking and the now 15-year-old Quartz successfully accomplished such a faultless round in the prize of the company Vitra GmbH. They won the international jumper class in the Medium Tour at Horses & Dreams meets Australia. A true precision landing, as the runner-up Jan Wernke came in only one-and-half tenth seconds slower with the Lord Pezi-son Lorelli. Only these two duos successfully accomplished the course, designed by Klaus Holle, in less than 58 seconds. Third place went to the Mexican Santiago Lambre with the KWPN-gelding Zeus de Buisson Z.
